REGULAR MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT FORM

Whereby the Applicant agrees that:

1. A regular member may be accepted by the Confederation after evaluation considering the following criteria:
 - a. Willingness to abide and comply with the particular provisions related to Regular Members in the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws and with the rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the Confederation;
 - b. Approval by a vote of the majority of the Board members in either a regular or special Board meeting;
 - c. Meets other criteria as approved by the Membership Committee.
2. A regular membership may be terminated by:
 - a. Failure to pay membership dues or any approved special assessment within ninety (90) days from written demand by PUC;
 - b. Expulsion due to any cause by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the entire members of the Board during a regular or special Board meeting;
 - c. Voluntary withdrawal by the regular member upon thirty (30) days prior written notice, but unpaid dues and/or assessments must be settled first before clearance is issued.
3. Separation of representative and/or alternate representative from employment for any reason shall automatically disqualify such representative/alternate representative from acting on behalf of the regular member provided however that the regular member will formally inform PUC in writing of such separation within two (2) days from knowledge thereof.

ARTICLE V

Members

Section 1. Qualifications for Membership – The Board shall determine the qualifications of an applicant association for membership. (as amended on 23 May 2013)

Section 2. Rights of Members - A member shall have the following rights:

- a. To exercise the rights to vote on all matter relating to the affairs of the Confederation; (as amended on 23 May 2013)
- b. To be eligible to any elective or appointive office of the Confederation; (as amended on 23 May 2013)
- c. To participate in all deliberations/meetings of the Confederation; (as amended on 23 May 2013)
- d. To avail of all the facilities of the Confederation; (as amended on 23 May 2013)
- e. To examine all the records or books of the Confederation during business hours. (as amended on 23 May 2013)

Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities of the Member-Associations – A member-association shall have the following duties and responsibilities: (as amended on 23 May 2013)

- a. To obey and comply with the By-Laws, rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the Confederation from time to time; (as amended on 23 May 2013)
- b. To attend all meetings that may be called by the Board of Trustees;
- c. To pay membership dues and other assessments of the Confederation. (as amended on 23 May 2013)
